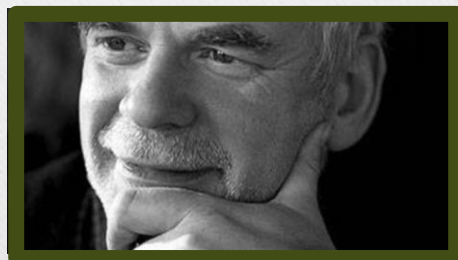


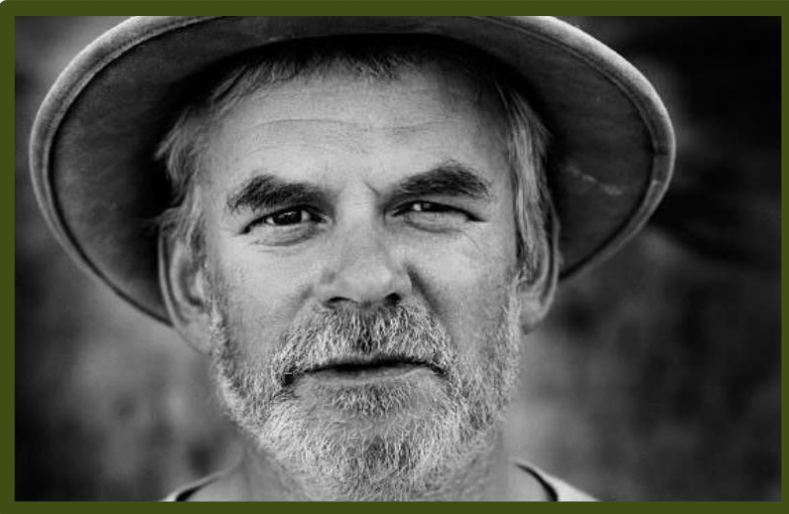
Andy Goldsworthy
