

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT is made between HAMILTON COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by its Board of County Commissioners, referred to in this agreement as "County";

and

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF HAMILTON COUNTY, FLORIDA, a corporate body politic pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Florida, referred to in this agreement as "School Board".

BACKGROUND FACTS:

The School Board has recently completed construction of a new elementary school and intends to use SW 55th Drive, an existing County dirt road, for school buses to access the elementary school.

The County has determined that the utility and safety of the SW 55th Drive will be improved by placing and compacting asphalt millings on the surface of said road.

The School Board has agreed to help defray the County's costs of improving said road by paying for the materials to be used by the County Road Department for improving SW 55th Drive.

County and School Board has agreed as follows:

1. The County will place and compact asphalt millings on SW 55th Drive from its intersection with U.S. Highway 129 to the school bus entrance at the new elementary school, finishing the work before the beginning of school on August 28, 2017.

2. The School Board will reimburse the County for the cost of the 1166 tons of asphalt millings required to do the work at the rate of \$22.00 per ton for a total of \$25,652.00.

This agreement will be effective immediately upon execution by the parties.


